Let's Get Started

Episode Theme: Serving Others- God Calls His People

- 1. The Old Testament book of <u>Proverbs</u> gives lots of friendship advice. What does it mean to you to be a good friend?
- 2. Sometimes, being a good friend means putting aside something that we care about for our friends. As you listen to this episode, think about David and Jonathan's friendship. What did they do for each other as friends, and how did Jonathan put aside his safety and future for his friend David?

Memory Verse

Jonathan said to David, "Go in peace, for we have sworn friendship with each other in the name of the Lord, saying, 'The Lord is witness between you and me, and between your descendants and my descendants forever." Then David left, and Jonathan went back to the town.

After You Listen

The story of David and Jonathan is one of great friendship. Jonathan went to great lengths to protect David from his father Saul, and David looked after Jonathan's children long after he died. Great friends do those kinds of things for each other. In <u>John 15:13</u>, Jesus tells his disciples that there is no greater love than that of someone willing to die for a friend. You probably won't be called on to give up your life for your friends, but a big part of friendship is putting your friends' needs before yours.

The best part of <u>John 15:13</u> is that Jesus did that for us. He laid down his life for us. That is how far he went for his love and friendship for us.

You can read more about David and Jonathan's friendship in the books of <u>1 and 2 Samuel</u>. Want to dig deeper and learn more about Jesus' love for us? Check out John 3:16, 1 John 4:7-21, and Romans 5:8.

Challenge

Make a list of your closest friends. Or, maybe draw a picture of you and them together doing something that you all love to do. Over the next few weeks, try to do something special for each of them. Maybe bring their favorite snack to share, play their favorite game with them, or invite them on a family outing. As you do things with and for your friends, thank God for his gift of friendship and the friends in your life.

Answer: Mephibosheth.
