#### Let's Get Started

**Episode Theme:** Worshiping God - God Calls His People (Genesis—Ruth)

- 1. Name some ways that we can hear God's voice today.
- 2. How do we learn to listen to God? Jesus says that his sheep know the voice of their shepherd. As you listen to this episode, think about how well you listen to God's voice.

## **Memory Verse**

Suddenly, a voice <em>came</em> to him and said, "What are you doing here, Elijah?"
1 Kings 19:13

#### After You Listen

God may not speak directly to us as he did with Elijah, but he still speaks in many ways.

Through the Bible, God shows who he is and what our role is in his creation. Here, God speaks, and we understand how he saves and cares for us.

"The heavens declare the glory of the Lord," and God's creation reminds us how big and wonderfully creative our God is.

God speaks through his Holy Spirit, who is with us and guides us through life situations. God loves us and equips us to do our work (<u>Acts 1:8</u>). The Holy Spirit teaches us and reminds us of what Christ did and said (<u>John 14:26</u>, <u>John 15:26</u>).

When you study scripture together, you can discover how God is leading you. As you read God's word, listen to the advice of godly people.

Spend time talking with and listening to God in prayer. Prayer isn't just your to-do list for God; it's also listening to what God wants you to do.

It'll take practice, but if you spend time reading the Bible, praying, and trying to hear God, you will recognize God's voice when he speaks to you.

Read more stories about Elijah in <u>1 Kings 17-19</u> and <u>2 Kings 1-2</u>. Want to dig deeper and learn more about listening to God's voice? Check out <u>1 Samuel 1; Matthew 17:5</u>; <u>John 10:27-30</u> and <u>Romans 10:17</u>.

### Challenge

The story of Elijah and the Still Small Voice is a great reminder when we are discouraged. We need to listen hard to what God is saying to us. We just need to be still enough, quiet enough, and listen hard enough to hear his voice when it comes.

When you are discouraged, where do you go to listen to God? You can read the Bible, take a walk in God's creation, pray to God, talk to godly people for advice, or ask the Holy Spirit to guide your next steps.

Question 1: Who were the king and queen of Israel?

Answer: King Ahab and Queen Jezebel.

Question 2: When the angel met Elijah in the desert, what did the angel give him?

**Answer:** He gave him water and bread.

Question 3: List the three ways God showed Elijah his power before he came in a still, small voice.

**Answer:** There was a powerful wind, a mighty earthquake, and an intense fire.

Question 4: What question did God ask Elijah?

Answer: He asked, "Elijah, why are you here?"

Question 5: What did God say to Elijah to send him on his way?

**Answer:** He gave Elijah the task of anointing Hazael, Jehu, and Elisha and reassured him that 7,000 people had not bowed down to Baal.
