I often dramatized my reading, with Goliath bellowing a menacing voice or the serpent hissing his temptation of Eve or Jesus forcefully sending his tempter packing, "Away from me, Satan! <u>The Story of Cain and Abel</u>. How terrible is sin? Listen to the story of these two brothers, Cain and Abel. We humans look at the outward appearance of a person, but God looks at the heart. God saw the hearts of Abel and his brother, Cain.

<u>Noah's Ark</u>. Sometimes what God asks of us isn't easy. Meet Noah and his family. "The Lord saw how great the wickedness of the human race had become on the earth" (Genesis 6:5). Can you imagine what these people thought when Noah started building an ark?

<u>The Tower of Babel</u>. In this story from the Old Testament, people worked together so that they thought they no longer needed God. To remind them that they need him, he gave them many languages and spread them across the Earth.
