Take a few minutes to read the Bible verses listed and ask the Holy Spirit to lead you in how this verse applies to you this week.


Joshua 1:1-9

Do you like to make plans? By making plans, you can be excited about what's coming, and you can anticipate what you may need to prepare. Plans can be little, like a plan to play tag at recess. Plans can be big, like figuring out a future career when you grow up. But, did you know God has made even *bigger* plans for you?

In the Bible, there's a story about a man named Joshua. Joshua had been Moses' assistant for many years. One day, Moses passed away. Joshua was probably pretty sad that Moses was gone. But now it was Joshua's time to lead God's people into the promised land. God spoke to Joshua. He said, "I will always be with you and help you." God commanded Joshua, "... be strong and brave. Don't ever be afraid or discouraged! I am the Lord your God, and I will be there to help you wherever you go." Even though Joshua was about to go on a wild, risky adventure, he could trust God's plan.

Even if it's clear that God's plans are different from ours, we don't have to be afraid or discouraged. After all, God knows everything that has happened to you, and he knows everything that will happen to you. He cares about the little things and the big things, and he's made a *perfect* plan for your life. Our job is to ask God for help, worship him, and trust that he knows what is best for us. By trusting God's plan, we can be strong and courageous like Joshua. Just like Joshua, we can be excited to follow God on the amazing adventure he has planned for us!
