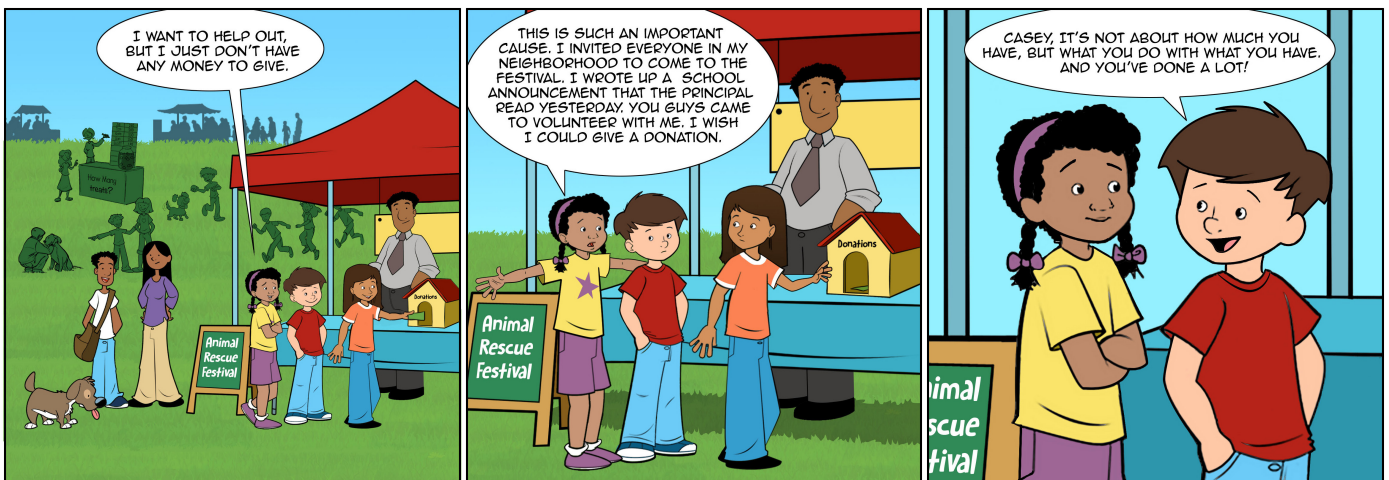
<sup>16</sup> But don't forget to help others and to share your possessions with them. This too is like offering a sacrifice that pleases God.
