Memory Verse

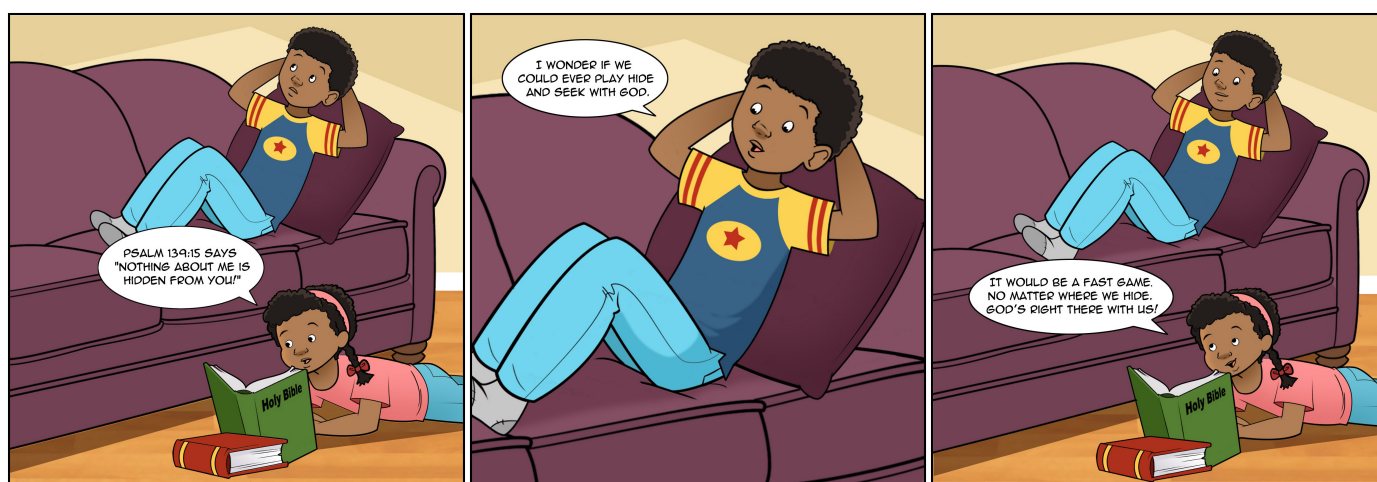

Do you ever wonder if God is really there? We can't see him, after all. When we're alone or afraid, it can be very hard to believe that God is with us. And sometimes, when we're sad or ashamed of something we've done, it can be very hard to believe that God would even want to be with us. How can we know that God is there?

David wrote Psalm 139 to remind himself of the truth that God never left him alone. God wouldn't be God if he couldn't be everywhere at once. But the Bible also says that God *wants* to be with you all the time. He wants to be with you so much that he knit you together in your mother's womb (Psalm 139:13-14). Nothing, not even sin, can separate you from the love of God in Christ.

You can know that God is with you because he promises to be with you in his Word. You can know he is with you when he takes care of your needs throughout the day. And you can talk to him at any time; praying

will help you know that he is with you. No matter where you hide, how far you run, or how bad you feel, God will always be there. He will never leave you nor forsake you.
