Do you ever feel like Maya? Maybe you don't like it when your favorite season slips away, or perhaps you worry when a school year with a beloved teacher ends. Maybe you don't enjoy all the responsibilities that come with growing up. Sometimes, circumstances feel unsettling or disappointing.

Thousands of years ago, God's servant Paul traveled the ancient world, teaching people about Jesus' love for all people. As he traveled from place to place, Paul experienced different cultures and met new people. Sometimes, he had a safe shelter and good food to eat. Other times, he found himself in prison, suffering at the hands of his enemies, the Romans. Yet Paul wrote letter after letter to fellow Jesus-followers, reminding them of God's *never-changing* love.

In the book of Romans, Paul teaches that experiencing difficulties can lead to strength and hope.

How does that work?

Paul says God sent his Holy Spirit to surround us with a love that never changes and never leaves us. We can trust that love completely, even when things around us change in ways we struggle to understand.
Thank you, Lord, that your love never changes!
