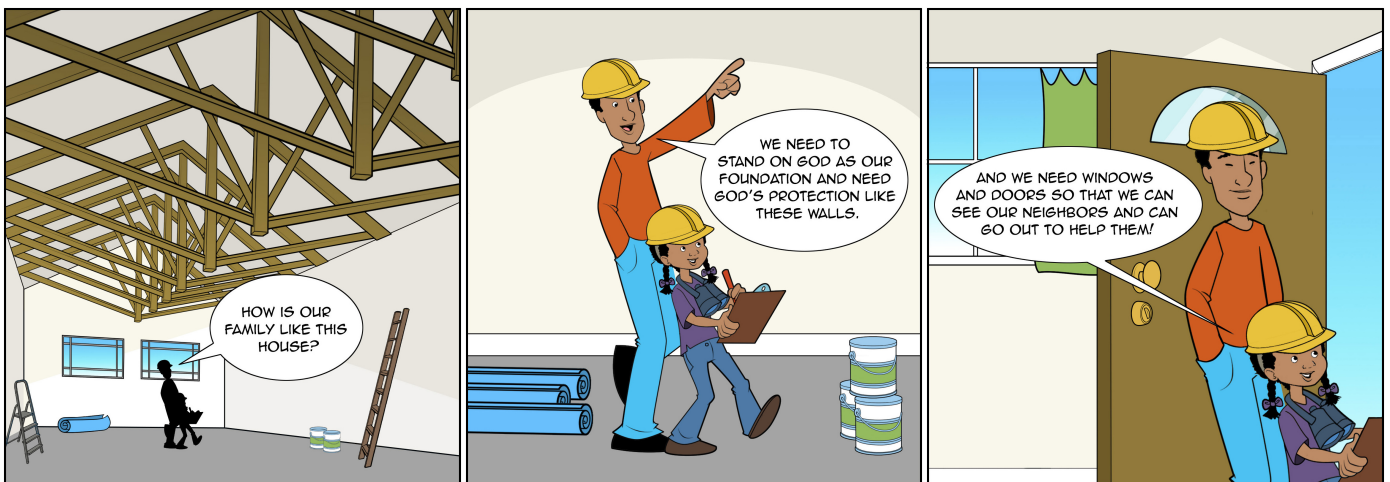
<sup>7</sup> and tell them to your children over and over again. Talk about them all the time, whether you're at home or walking along the road or going to bed at night, or getting up in the morning.

Take a moment to draw your home.

Just like an actual house, we need a foundation. Deuteronomy 6:5 describes a good foundation, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." Then, in verse 7, the foundation is strengthened every time your family talks about obeying God.

The door allows us to step out from our home and into a world that needs our help and God's restoration. God is calling your family to find ways to serve the neighbors and friends in your community faithfully.

Has your family chosen to commit to serving God? Have *you*? Your family can create a home that loves and faithfully obeys God! What a blessing!
