After the party, he said, "I love all my presents—now I have everything I wanted." Troy's dad replied, "We're glad you like your gifts, but remember these are just *things*. They can't bring you real joy."

Troy wondered what his dad meant. Over the next few weeks, Troy spent all his money, beat all the levels on his new game, and then broke his remote control car. One day he looked around his room at all the cool "stuff" he had, but he couldn't understand why he felt *empty*. Then he remembered what his dad told him on his birthday. "Is this what Dad meant about where real joy comes from?" he wondered.

Joy comes from our relationship with God through Jesus. In John 15:9-11, Jesus teaches us that we will find peace and joy when we stay close to him and obey the Bible. The love we have for God helps us obey his Word. When we follow God's commands, he fills us with a spirit of hope and joy (Psalm 19:8 and 119:1-2). Joy is not about what we own, but what we have in our hearts.

God loves us and will always be with us. That's a great reason to be full of joy. We may have new clothes, tons of toys, or be liked by everybody, but none of that will bring us the joy of our relationship with God. We will outgrow clothes, break toys, and lose popularity, but our relationship with God is *eternal*. Joy does not depend on what happens to you. It is about what God is doing inside you.
