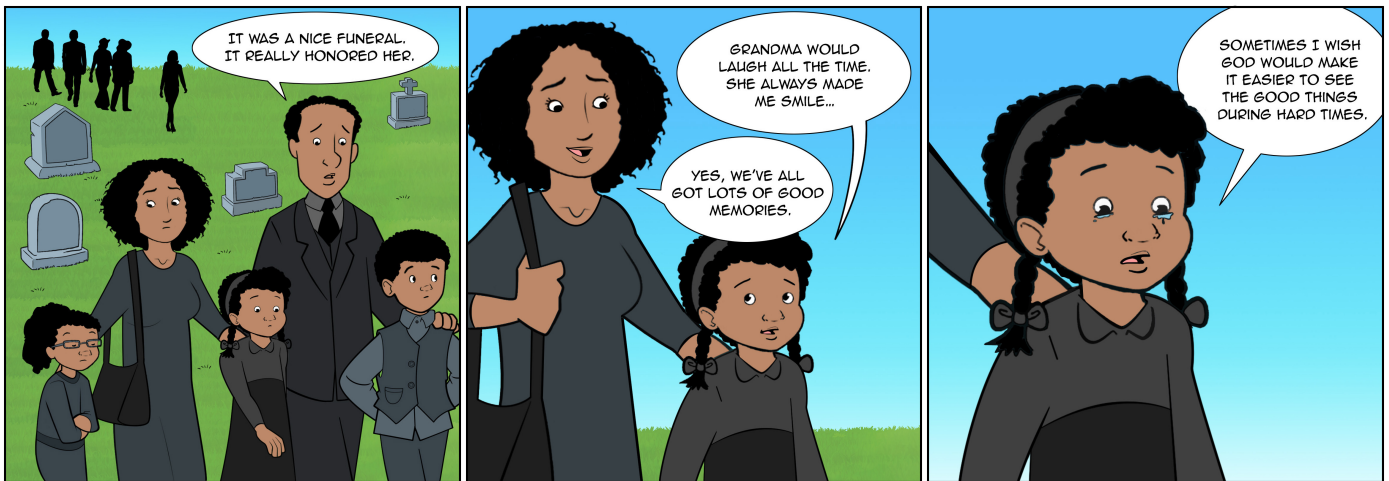
“I will give you treasures hidden in dark and secret places. Then you will know that I, the Lord God of Israel, have called you by name.” (CEV)

Have you ever felt like that? God understands those feelings of disappointment. In fact, both [Isaiah 45:3](#) and [2 Corinthians 4:7-12](#) warn us that not everything is going to be easy. But, the verses also tell us that when life is hard, God is still there for us. In fact, he's hidden gifts for us in those hard times to remind us that he

has called us by name, that we haven't been left on our own, and that we will get through it.

That doesn't mean you need to be happy when life isn't going the way you want it to. It's okay to be discouraged, sad, or angry. But, when you are struggling, try looking for these gifts, because they can make your situation seem brighter.

Sometimes it's not easy to see him or his presents. For example, all Trevor sees is that his best friend moved away. But in a few weeks, he might be really good friends with his new neighbor. Maybe he and his best friend will love sending each other letters. Or he might grow closer to his other friends. Or perhaps it will be something else.
