Early on a Sunday morning, Mary Magdalene felt very sad; in fact, she felt hopeless. Her teacher and friend had been crucified on Friday, and now, mysteriously, his tomb was empty. Mary stood alone outside the tomb, crying. But when she turned around, she saw a man standing there. She thought, "He must be the gardener." He asked her, "Why are you crying? Who are you looking for?" She asked him to please tell her where Jesus' body had been taken.

But then, the man said one word, and Mary realized that it wasn't the gardener. He said, "Mary!" and she knew that it was Jesus. He had done what he came to the earth to do: he had defeated sin and death. He had risen! Jesus told Mary to go and tell the others the good news. She ran as fast as she could to tell their friends Jesus was—and is—alive!

Sometimes in life, we may feel like Mary. We may feel alone and hopeless. Jesus may seem far away. But while we are still crying, he stands beside us. And if we are listening to his voice, he says our name. Suddenly, our eyes recognize that Jesus was with us all along, and he will always be with us. Jesus transforms our hopelessness into *hopefulness*; our tears into joy. When we know that our Savior lives, we live in the freedom his resurrection gives us. And like Mary, we run as fast as we can to share the good news that he has risen indeed.

Please help us to live each day in the joy of Jesus' resurrection and to share the good news of the gospel so more people may know that Jesus has risen. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
