Have you ever told a fib? Maybe you told your parents you picked up your room, when you really hadn't. Maybe you made up an excuse for not doing your homework. Maybe you exaggerated a story to impress someone else. Believe it or not, lies that seem small can hurt others, and we eventually have to pay the cost for them.

The Bible tells us about the first lies that were told. Adam and Eve lived in the Garden of Eden, a paradise, but a serpent lied to them about God's goodness. Then, they disobeyed God, tried to hide their sin, and then blamed others for what they had done. In the same way, we tell lies when we hide something, but God wants us to live lives of honesty. God doesn't just tell the truth; he *is* the truth! Jesus told his disciples, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6). Even though Adam and Eve suffered bad consequences for their sin, God still took care of them. He covered their sins. We may feel ashamed when we mess up, but

Jesus took the punishment for our sins. He covers our sins with his grace and teaches us the truth in his Word.

Today's verse tells us when you welcome God into your heart, you become a new person. New people don't lie; they love their neighbors by telling the truth in love. And while lies come at a price, the truth sets us free! (See John 8:32.)
