After You Listen

In the story, Kenan follows the group and gets deeper into trouble, because he wants the other boys to be his friends. Liz is involved at first, but when Miss Wattle shares [Philippians 1:10](#) – "so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ," Liz knows that he needs to do what is best, pure and blameless.

Challenge

Family activity:

Draw a vertical line down the middle of a piece of paper to create two columns. At the top of the left column, write the title "Good Ways People Use Technology." At the top of the right column, write the title "Bad Ways People Use Technology." As a family, talk about and write down how people have used technology—like computers or their phones—in both good and bad ways.
