Episode Theme: What is God's will for us?

- 1. How do you know what is right? What's better: playing sports, reading books, talking to your friends, or watching television? Which one would you choose?
- 2. <u>1 Kings 3:5-13</u> tells the story of Solomon. Solomon was a young man when his father King David died. One night God appeared to Solomon in a dream and said, "Solomon, ask for anything you want, and I will give it to you." Wow! Solomon was already king of God's nation. What could King Solomon possibly want? Solomon said, "Please make me wise and teach me the difference between right and wrong." God was very pleased with Solomon's request. He gave Solomon the wisdom he asked for. But he also gave Solomon riches and fame. If God asked you the same question, what would you ask for? As you listen to today's episode, think about how Solomon's request helped him with the all the other things God gave him.

#### After You Listen
