#### Let's Get Started

**Episode Theme:** Working together and appreciating individual gifts.

- 1. <u>1 Corinthians 12:18-19, 27</u> says that everyone who worships God is part of one body. What does that mean?
- 2. In Matthew 10:2-4, Jesus called twelve people to be his disciples. Each of them were different in their own way. A few were Galilean fishermen with strong muscles, rough hands, and a good attitude for work. Matthew was a tax collector. He worked with the Romans and profited from his fellow Jews. Simon the Zealot was a rebel. He wanted to free the Jews from the Romans. I wonder how Simon and Matthew got along. Judas kept the money for everyone. I wonder if he volunteered for that job or if he had a gift for that sort of thing. What gifts did Jesus see in each of his disciples? How did they become a good team and the future of the Church? Think about what makes a good team as you listen to today's episode.

#### After You Listen

### Challenge

As a family or group of friends keep a beach ball, volleyball, or balloon in the air for a specified number of hits without letting it hit the ground. ## Take the Episode Quiz

**Question 1:** When Liz is filming, he lists three different jobs that he has to learn to be the best movie maker possible. What are those three jobs?

**Answer:** Writing, directing, and special effects.

Question 2: Liz quotes James 1:22. What does that verse say? Why does Liz like that verse?

**Answer:** James 1:22 says, "Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves." Liz likes the verse because he wants to be a doer.

Question 3: What does Liz call the team of Cole, Kayla, Kenan and himself?

Answer: The Extreme Dream Team.

**Question 4:** Which team member becomes the writer, the director, the actor, the special effect designer, and the producer?

**Answer:** Lucille is the writer. Cole is the director. Kayla is the actor. Kenan is the special effects designer. Liz is the producer.
