Caleb said, "We should go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly do it." The people did not agree, and God sent his people back into the desert. But God saw that Caleb was different. In [Numbers 14:24](#), God said, "But my servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit and has followed me fully, I will bring into the land into which he went, and his descendants shall possess it." How can we be like Caleb and have a "different spirit" and follow God fully? Think about Caleb as you listen to today's program.

Peculiar means strange, odd, or unusual. How are you a peculiar member of God's family? As a member of God's family, you are under God's love and care. And in thankfulness for all God has given you, you are called to live and behave like a unique child of God.
